


Congratulations to our Archers of the Day!

One Week Until Field Day!




Please thoroughly review all information sent out by homeroom teachers.

Spectators: Although the opportunities to volunteer are limited, all parents (and grandparents) are welcome to attend as spectators! Parking will not be available on our campus, and as always, parking in local businesses is strictly prohibited. Please park in the soccer fields at the <u>Bell 94 Sports</u> <u>Complex</u> and walk over to our campus. Enter our field from the northwest corner to view from the sidelines. Due to campus security protocols, spectators may not enter the field with the competitors. (See here for our pedestrian <u>map</u>. Follow the pedestrian path from 94th St. until you enter our parking lot at the northeast corner. Continue to walk west along our playground/carline until you enter the field at the northwest corner.)

Dress: Each section is assigned a color from the Olympics logo: **A B C D E F** Students are encouraged to wear their team color or an ACS Spirit Wear shirt. ACS Spirit Wear hats are also acceptable. Shirts and hats must be free of pop culture, large logos, and text/slogans. Sports logos are permitted. Students can wear regular uniform bottoms or athletic bottoms that come just above the knee (or longer) such as shorts, pants, leggings, or skorts. Bottoms such as bike shorts, cheer shorts, or pajama pants are <u>not</u> allowed. Students should also wear regular uniform shoes.

Lunch: There will be NO HOT LUNCH on Field Day. All students will bring a lunch to eat in the classroom.
