### **For Smartphone Users:**

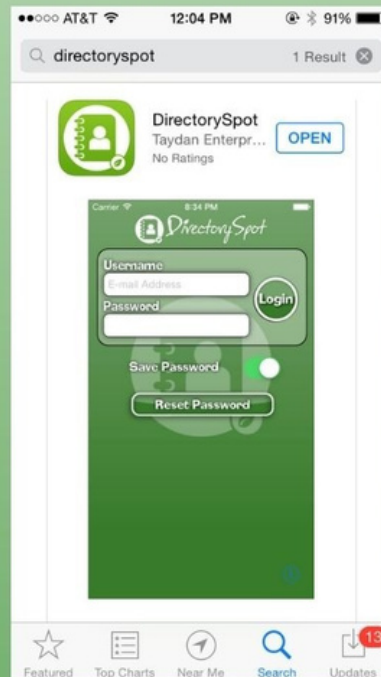
1. Download the DirectorySpot app by going to your app store and searching "DirectorySpot" or by clicking on the appropriate link down below.

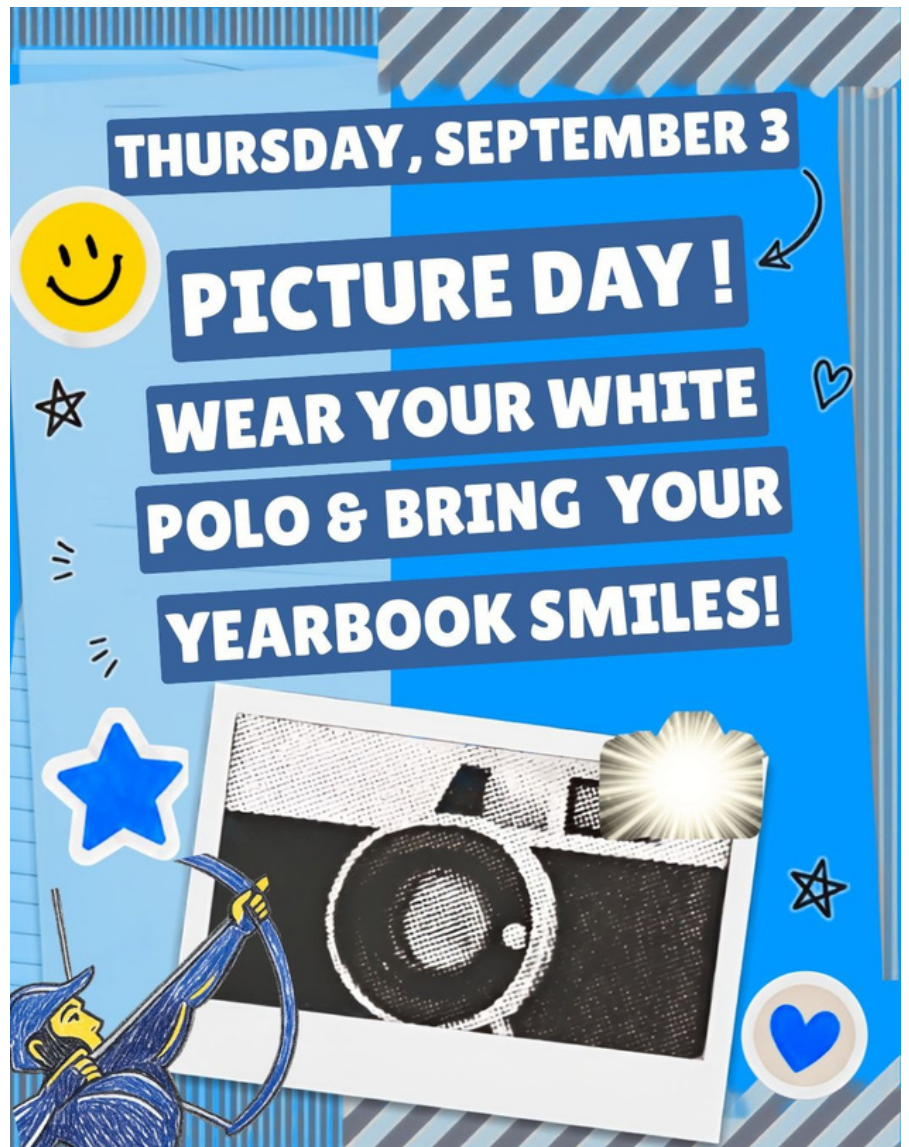
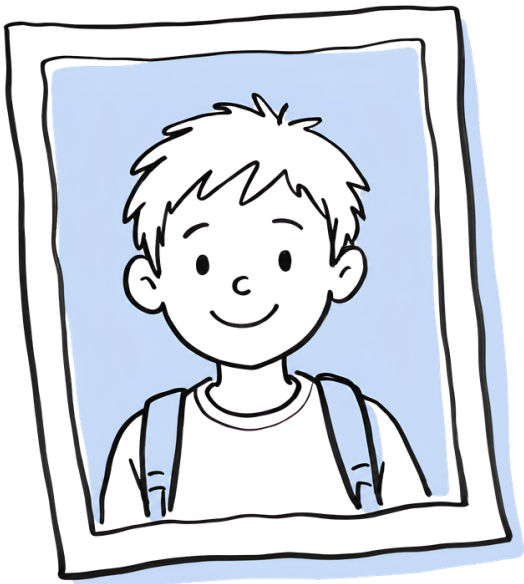
**Archer Days are every Friday this year!**

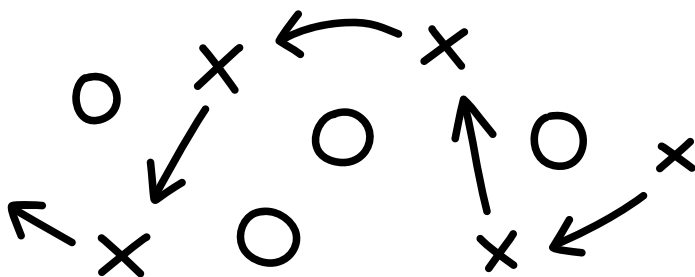
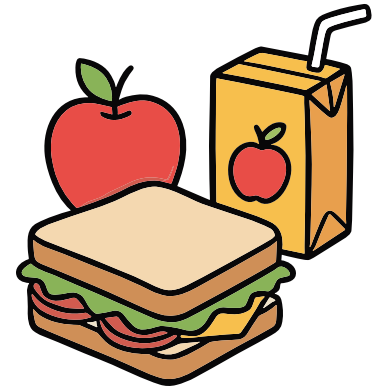

All students in Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, and 5th grades will receive hearing screening. All students in Kindergarten and 3rd grade will receive vision screening.
